| <p><b>Who Should Attend?</b><br/><i>This meetings are intended for individuals serving as non-licensed, non-clinical, front line workers in the community and who are seeking to improve health outcomes for individuals, families or groups.</i></p> <p><i>The meeting is <u>not intended</u> for administrators, or actively-licensed personnel such as nurses, social workers, or mental health professionals.</i></p>  | <p><b>Who is a Community Health Worker?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The CHW serves as a bridge or link between people and services to improve health.</li> <li>• The CHW knows and understands the community.</li> <li>• The CHW is a non-clinical member of a care team.</li> </ul> <p>May be known by many titles: CHW, outreach worker, navigator, <i>promotora</i>, parent resource coordinator, health advocate, peer counselor.</p> |
| <p><b>Why Should Community Health Workers Attend?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Share your experiences and wisdom about what it means to be a community health worker</li> <li>• Learn about health topics and skills you can use</li> <li>• Make new friends and contacts who are CHWs</li> <li>• If you attend on your own time, and are not being paid by an employer, earn a small stipend.</li> </ul>  |  |
