

PCACOAD Membership Application

In times of disaster, everyone has something they can contribute to their community. Your membership ensures that resources you offer to the community will be used in the most efficient and effective way possible.

PCACOAD membership will include organizations or individuals that have the resources to help meet the needs of the community at the time of a disaster including, but not limited to: transportation, case management in emergency assistance, local health department, non-profits and faith-based organizations, local government, civic groups, businesses, schools, emergency management agencies, etc. These member organizations must have disaster response programs and policies for commitment of resources to meet the needs of people affected by disaster without discrimination. Member organizations must be willing and able to provide voluntary services during and/or following disasters.

Each member organization is responsible for appointing a representative to attend PCACOAD business and special meetings. The representative must be knowledgeable and have access to the resources of their organization to serve the needs of disaster victims. PCACOAD member organizations also designate one alternate representative to attend PCACOAD meetings. Members shall notify the secretary or chair if unable to attend a meeting.

PCACOAD member organizations may voluntarily withdraw by submission of a letter of separation. An organization's membership may be terminated by consistent failure to meet the conditions and responsibilities of membership.
