COVID-19 Deaths Announced

KEARNEY –Two Rivers Public Health Department is announcing 3 additional deaths due to COVID-19. The total number of deaths due to COVID-19 in the district is 200. The individuals ranged in age from their 70s to 90s.

These deaths occurred February 2022.

Two Rivers Public Health Department encourages a layered approach to preventing the spread of COVID-19:

- Wash your hands frequently
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth
- Cover your mouth when you cough using a tissue or the bend of your elbow
- Avoid crowded places and close contact with anyone who has fever or cough
- Seek medical care early if you have a fever, coughs, and difficulty breathing- please call ahead
- Get information from trusted sources
